How do I apply a 3D FX Transfer?

How do I remove a 3D FX Transfer?

Before removing your 3D FX Transfer, wipe off the excess blood or goo with warm water and towel. Next, very gently begin to rub or pull up the edge of the 3D FX Transfer and then roll it onto itself. It begins to peel up like an old bandage. Once removed use an adhesive remover or baby oil to remove residual 3D FX Transfer. Rinse the skin using a towel with warm water.

Do I have to apply makeup to 3D FX Transfers?

Totally up to you! Our 3D FX Transfers are pre-painted, self-blending, and look frightfully realistic as soon as you apply them! However, adding blood or make up to your 3D FX Transfers can really add to your character for a more gruesome look. Any water, cream, or alcohol-based makeup can be used.

Are 3D FX Transfers reusable?

No. They can only be used once, but are easier and more realistic than any form of prosthetic currently available.

Will water or rain affect the 3D FX Transfers?

No. The 3D FX Transfers will stay intact through various weather situations including rain and are great for the outdoor actives, such as Halloween!

Are 3D FX Transfers safe for the skin?

3D FX Transfers are made with ingredients that are recognized as safe. As with any cosmetic, some people may have instances of sensitivity. Test by applying to the inside of the wrist and remove after 30 minutes.
